To the Constituents of Ward 10,

I would like to again take this opportunity to provide you with information on issues /projects that have been completed or are ongoing in our neighborhood this season. But first, I would like to start by saying Thank-You to all our volunteers within our community who volunteer their time to help with all our community projects. Without the help of volunteers it would be difficult if not impossible to have the success that our community is achieving with our two youth groups that operate out of our community centre, or our community newsletter and the many other events that are put on throughout the year for our community. Thank you all very much.

Information updates on projects for Ward 10 this season include resurfacing of Pioneer Drive, Robertson Road and a portion of Patterson Drive. This will make for smoother driving as these streets were quite rough especially when frost created heaving on these streets. Also as part of our overall plan for improvements in Ward 10, we have begun the replacement of asphalt curbing to the much stronger cement curbing. Areas that asphalt

curbing has been damaged and replaced by cement curbing include Glenthorne Ave., Patterson Dr. and Westridge Crescent .

This season, as in other seasons, we have continued with our sidewalk program as we continue to create safer walking for all our residents. Hunters Lane has been completed which now completes the connection from Northridge Parkway to Patterson Dr. Also St. Peters Road sidewalk will be completed this year connecting our communities and creating a much safer walking environment for all residents.

We have begun renovations to our Community Centre as the downstairs has been updated and refreshed to better serve our users. Please feel free to drop in and view the improvements any week day from 4:30pm -6:30pm or Friday night from 7:00pm – 9:00 pm as you can also see your youth from the community in action!

In December you will see renovations continue with the installation of new siding and new windows being installed to make our community Centre more

energy efficient.

As we are now currently involved in the budget process for the upcoming year, I will be looking to continue with improvements in Ward 10 such as continuing with our Sidewalk program and street resurfacing program , creating flower beds within the community and replacing asphalt curbing with cement curbing were appropriate. Also will be replacing some outdated playground equipment in our parks.
