## HILLSBOROUGH SUMMER YOUTH GROUP

On behalf of the Hillsborough promoters we are happy to announce that we will be running a summer program for youth ages 8-12. The hours of operation will be from 8:00am to 1:00pm Monday to Friday. The starting date is July 5 2010 and will run until September 3 2010. There will be a small registration fee of \$50.00 per month. We also offer a part time fee for 3 days or less per week of \$30.00 per month. Registration deadline is **June 14, 2010** and will be on a first come first serve bases. This cost will go towards payment for two student workers, supplies and lunches. Children are expected to bring their own lunch except for Friday's where lunch will be provided for them. This program will be directed by Esther Carroll Youth Coordinator, with the help of two students, and many volunteers who are dedicated to working with youth.

## Program Events Information

There is a full schedule of events found on our website or here in the centre highlighting the many fun and educational activities and experiences that your child will be involved in on a day to day basis. Every Monday is sports day featuring a different sport each week. Tuesday is guest speaker day where your child will learn from professionals different skills such as guitar lessons, kickboxing, drug and alcohol awareness, and how to stay healthy. We also have one trip per month to Victoria Park where the group will be transported by transit and spending the day at the park. Every Wednesday is art day where the children will explore different areas of creativity. The children will get a chance to showcase their work to the public the end of August where they will be involved in their very own Art Gallery held at the community centre. Friday will be Water Fun day; if it is raining it will be a movie day. Other activities include scavenger hunts, obstacle course, and a three day long summer Olympics and many others. The children will be helping to plan these events which will teach them about teamwork, organisation, and problem solving skills.

This program is designed to introduce youth to a wide variety of skills in art, music, culture, and sports. Our goal is for children in this program gain knowledge in a fun manner that is enjoyable to them.
